

Cowboys And Indians

New Zealand based musician Andrew Morriss has released his song "Cowboys And Indians", the first single from his forthcoming studio album "Bordertown". Mastered at world famous Abbey Road Studios and released through Andrew's own record label Refractive Music, "Cowboys And Indians" is available online through digital music retailers including iTunes.

"Writing the song I was influenced by all the scenes of war we see on TV all the time and also by living in a town that keeps on growing exponentially, with all of it's advantages and problems. Somehow these two ideas became mixed together with the imagery of old B-Grade Western movies and the song was born."

Andrew has a strong melodic style with a rich warm voice and melodic lead guitar interwoven with acoustic fingerpicking that incorporates the best of folk, pop, rock and blues.

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
